Hatching is an artistic technique used to create tonal or shading effects by drawing, painting or scribing closely spaced parallel lines. When lines are placed at an angle to one another, it is called **cross-hatching**. Hatching is especially important in essentially linear media, such as drawing, and many forms of printmaking, such as engraving, etching and woodcut. Artists use the technique, varying the length, angle, closeness and other qualities of the lines

The range of artwork is broad from the smallest 2"x3" print to extra-large 4'x8' banners; from abstracts to still life to life-size figures, all brought together by the simple idea and technique of the hatch line.
